Prints for the Mattara exhibition should be given to Katherine James by 1st September 2016.




Image Of The Year

2015 Landscape photographer award

At the end of 2015, John Schiller, an A Grade member of our Club, submitted a portfolio of 6 photographic images to the LANDSCAPE section of the annual "Australian Photographer of the Year" competition organised by the national "Australian Photography" magazine. The categories included Portrait, Landscape, Nature, Black & White, Junior Landscape and Junior Portrait. More than 6,000 images were submitted (i.e. over 1,000 portfolios) and assessed by a panel of 11 judges. Recently, John received an email saying "Your portfolio has been awarded a special commendation". John learned that he was in the top 50 photographers who submitted images in the Landscape section and received a "COMMENDED" for his portfolio of Antarctica images.


