The competition offers six sections:

- Prints - Monochrome (M), Colour (C), Nature (N)
- Digital - Open (OD), People, (PD) Macro (MD)

Maximum of 6 entries per entrant across the 6 sections, with a maximum of 2 entries per section.

Entry fee:

- Entry to photographic competition and convention weekend: \$45 per person
- Entry to convention weekend: \$50 per person
