The competition and conference are open to all members of affiliated camera clubs, which includes your camera club.

Venue: Kurri Kurri Bowling Club, Tarro Street, Kurri Kurri (next to McDonald's)

Key dates:

- 1st June, 2024 Photographic competition entries open
- 5th July 2024 Closing date for entrants to upload entries
- 12th July 2024 Deadline for bulk delivery of prints by clubs
- 27th and 28th July, 2024 Exhibition and presentation of awards at the NPF Convention
- 28th July 2024 Exhibition open to the public

Competition Summary:

The competition offers six sections:

- Prints Monochrome (M), Colour (C), Nature (N)
- Digital Open (OD), People, (PD) Macro (MD)

Maximum of 6 entries per entrant across the 6 sections, with a maximum of 2 entries per section.

Entry fee:

The entry fee for the NPF photographic competition is \$45. This fee covers both the photographic competition entry fees and entry to the NPF weekend convention. This fee is paid on the MyPhotoClub website as part of the entry process.

Entry fee to the NPF weekend, for camera club members who are **NOT** entering the NPF Photographic Competition is \$45. This fee is paid on the MyPhotoClub website as part of the registration process.
